### Bury Town Hall

Bury has many interesting and historic buildings. The Town Hall in Knowsley Street, where most of the Council meetings take place, has a fascinating history.

The foundation stone for the building was laid in 1939. The architects, Reginald Edmunds, were from Birmingham. The craftsmen were a local firm, Spencer & Clark Limited. The original cost was estimated to be £110,000.

The outbreak of the Second World War in 1939 meant that work was interrupted; only the basement and the first floor were built. During the war the Town Hall was used by the Home Guard (Dad's Army) and as an air raid shelter.

After the war work resumed and the building was officially opened on October 22, 1954 by the Queen.

Many Bury people turned out to welcome Queen Elizabeth II to our town in 1954. Several groups of scouts guides and cub scouts (including myself) proudly lined the route as Her Majesty made her way to the Town Hall. This was a great honour for the people of Bury and many of us felt privileged to be a part of a very special day in the history of our town.

Although public access to the Town Hall is now restricted for security reasons, it still belongs to all of us. It is possible for groups of people to visit the building by prior arrangement. If you would like to know more about the Town Hall or how the Council works, or you would like to have a look round the Council Chamber, I am happy to arrange a visit.

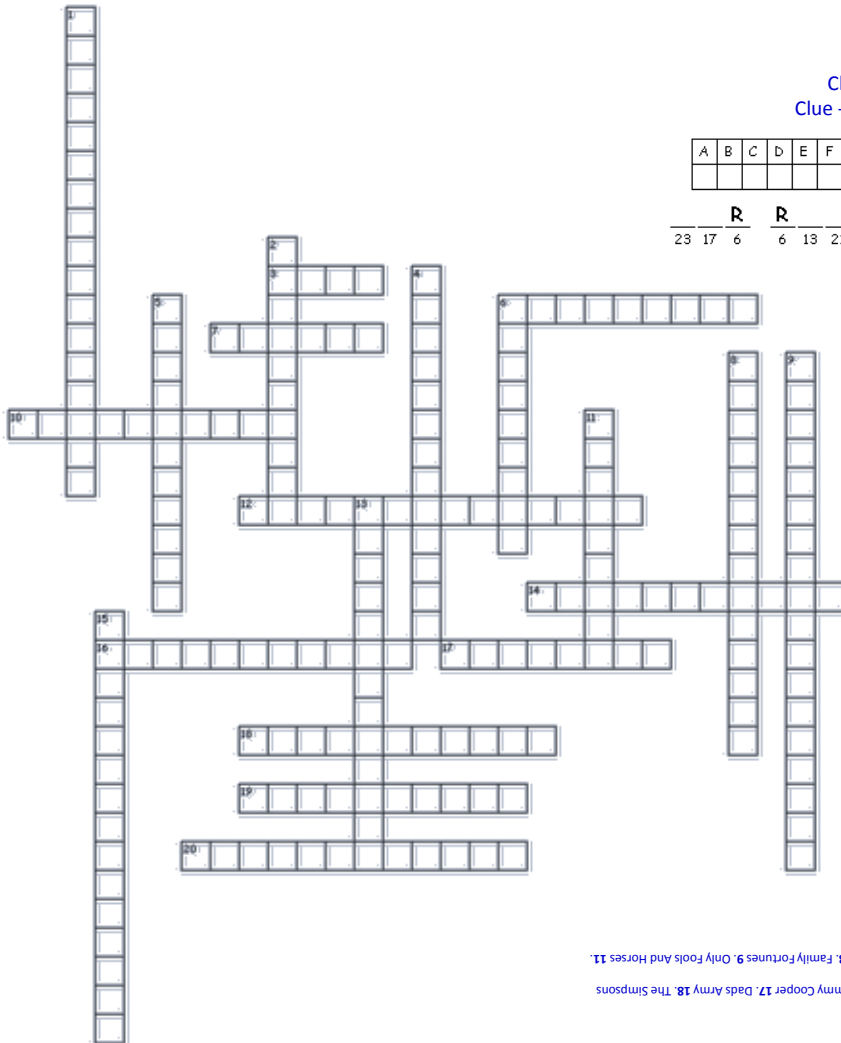
