- The Residents Association was formed to make Pimhole a better place for all Residents
- We are a non-political, non-religious organisation. We are here to support the Residents of Pimhole with any issues they may have in our community, these issues often include:

 - Street Lighting
 - Speeding Vehicles
 - Traffic Calming Measures
 - Pest Control
 - Street Repairs
 - General Nuisances
- All Residents of Pimhole are welcome to our meetings. This allows you to express your views/opinions/concerns in our community. Police, Council Officials, Councillors and other guests are often in attendance at our meetings to answer any questions that you may have.
- The Residents Association played a big part in the demolishing of the old houses and the building of the new houses from the start in 2002 til the final built houses in 2012.
- In the beginning meetings were held on the first Monday of every Month, over more recent years, we have had 6 meetings per year, and they are held on the first Monday of every 2nd Month
